Enrolment Policies

Membership Fee

\$105

per term

Membership fee allows enrolment in three (3) classes per student each term.

Enrolments for <u>more than 3 classes</u> will incur a \$20 surcharge per additional class each term. Enrolment is limited to 2 art classes per student each term.

Students must be 60 years or older to participate in classes at Uniting Seniors in the City. Students may enrol the term they turn 60.

Refund Policy

Withdrawals <u>prior</u> to the commencement of term will be refunded, deducting a \$5.00 administrative fee for processing the reimbursement bank transfer. **No refunds or credits will be given once term has commenced.**

Absentee Policy

If a student is absent from a fully booked class for 2 consecutive weeks or more <u>without explanation</u>, their place in the class may be offered to the next student on the waiting list. Fees will still be payable.

To prevent losing your place in a class, please notify Reception regarding absences/extended holiday arrangements in advance. Any late notice absences can be communicated to Reception by telephone or email. If you have not been attending classes for genuine extenuating circumstances, upon return to USIC, Admin staff will do their best to accommodate you back in your usual classes.
